TERMS AND CONDITIONS (FOR PHD FROM PIEAS IT-EF)

PIEAS Information Technology & Telecom Endowment Fund (PIEAS IT-EF) offers stipend to selected candidates for IT and Telecom related fields. The students who will obtain these scholarships are hereby called ITEF-Scholars. Following are the term and conditions against which the award is offered.

- 1) The ITEF-Scholar will be paid lumpsum monthly stipend of Rs. 35,000/- (Thirty Five Thousands) only during the approved study period by the Executive Committee/BoT.
- 2) The payment of stipend will be made to the scholars through bank only.
- 3) All university dues including tuition fee, admission fee, registration fee, students club fee, examination fee, security fee, PERN/Digital Library charges, hostel charges, mess charges, transport charges, etc. shall be borne by the scholar.
- 4) If an ITEF-Scholar fails/terminates/leaves the PhD after joining, before completion of the degree, he/she has to pay back the entire received stipend and any other received benefit to the PIEAS IT & Telecom Endowment Fund.
- 5) Funding period is for 3 years if a scholar is admitted/registered on IT-EF funding subject to satisfactory performance, which is evaluated at the end of each semester by the PIEAS IT-EF Executive Committee.
 - a. Extension in study period, maximum of six months, is subject to timely completion of all qualifying examinations and publication of a Journal paper (as per PIEAS policy) as first author.
 - b. At the end of each semester, scholar must submit copy of result report to the IT-EF office.
- 6) The award of the fund will be effective from the date decided by PIEAS ITEF. And there will be no reimbursement of any stipend or fee for the period of one's self finance study.
- 7) Dual funding is not allowed. The scholar must inform the office about the acceptance of any other scholarship/funding from other sources.
- 8) The ITEF-Scholar has to pledge a bond on a Stamp paper (minimum of Rs. 100) to serve the country for 5 years after graduation.
- 9) The scholar must be a full time student during his/her PhD study period.
- 10) The scholarship is subject to satisfactory performance, which is evaluated at the end of each semester. Therefore at the end of each semester, scholars have to submit copy of semester result report and Academic Progress Report on prescribed form to IT-EF office.
- 11) It is compulsory to maintain minimum 3 CGPA for the continuity of the funding.

- 12) The timeline defined by CGSR for taking Qualifying Examination will be observed strictly and failing in that will result in withdrawal of the funding.
- 13) The selected PhD scholar has to do TA ship for 3 contact hours per week per semester for 2 semesters in the first year. However after first year he/she has to do TA ship of 9 contact hours per week per semester.
- 14) Under this scheme, Laptop will not be provided.
- 15) The ITEF-Scholar has to submit soft and hard copies of his/her thesis and research papers written during PhD studies, to the IT-EF office.
- 16) The ITEF-Scholar must give due acknowledgement to “PIEAS IT & Telecom Endowment Fund” in his/her each publication (paper/thesis).
- 17) The decisions of the office of the PIEAS IT & Telecom Endowment Fund will deemed to be final and can't be challenged in any court of law.
- 18) The rules may be added to or modified as required from time to time, on the instructions of BoT of the PIEAS IT-EF Management.

DECLARATION

All the above-mentioned terms and conditions are acceptable to me. I will abide by them, and I have no objection if the institute withdraws the funding/support due to non-fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the PIEAS IT-EF. In case of withdrawal of the funding I must reimburse all stipend to the PIEAS ITEF.
